You can activate or withdraw your team members before deadline. After deadline all changes can be done ONLY by organizing committee. After deadline we cannot guarantee start at the competitions, but we try our best.

Referees: Register on-line till Wed October 05, 2022 23:59 EEST

Entry fee: 30 Euro for 1 competitor / 50 Euro for 1 competitor after deadline (05 Oct. 2022)
Can be paid to organizer bank account as deposit (paragraph 6) or can be paid in cash at the time of team registration on 14th of October 2022. Team leaders are responsible to pay for all team members in single payment (not separately by each competitor).

Trophies and awards:



We award all individual winners for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place with medals and diploma of competitions. The winners in Team Overall will be awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place with Team Cups and diplomas.

Athletes who have won prizes must be present at the awarding ceremony and go out for rewards dressed **a team sports suit or in Dobok**.

Athletes who do not show up for the awards will forfeit their awards. The awards of athletes who did not show up for the awards ceremony **will not be given to coaches!**

Number of referees:

Each club (team) ensures at least 1-2 qualified referees for the whole day. The referees must be dressed according to the ITF rules. All referees have the obligation to attend the registration together with the competitors from their team. If the team does not have judge for the work in this competition, so it loses the rights to make a protest. The Organizing committee will pay 30 EUR for umpire for working day bonus money by cash and the dinner in the day of Events.

Registration & weight-in on Friday 14th October 2022 from 15:00 to 20:00;

Place of registration will be announced later. Competitors must show on registration:

- passport or ID-Card;
- ITF Dan/Kup certificate or ITF membership booklet.

The coach must attend registration and the weight-in.



PROPOSITIONS

- 1. AGE DIVISIONS:** Cadets (11-13 y. o) / B-class (6 gup – 1 gup), A-class (1 dan - 2 dan)
 Juniors (14-15 y. o) / B-class (6 gup – 1 gup), A-class (1 dan - 2 dan)
 Juniors (16-17 y. o) / B-class (6 gup – 1 gup), A-class (1 dan - 3 dan)
 Adults (18-35 y. o) / B-class (6 gup – 1 gup), A-class (1 dan - 4 dan)
 Veterans (36-56 y. o) / B-class (6 gup – 1 gup), A-class (1 dan - 6 dan)

Age of competitors will be controlled by their ID. From each club is allowed unlimited number of competitors in each division. Participants must have a medical insurance policy valid at the time of the competition in the territory of Latvia.

2. Disciplines and categories:

Juniors, Adults and Veterans male, female will compete in patterns, sparring and power test.

Will be only one designated pattern in preliminary bouts and two patterns (optional & designated) in final & semi-final.

2.2. Individual Sparring.

- 2.3. Cadets & Juniors will be spitted into **A-Class** (Black belts) and **B-Class** (color belts), competitors from B-class will start in first rounds of competition, but black belts will be seeded closer to the final in the competition grid in each weight category. So, can be possible in semi-final or final if best color belt will compete with black belt owner for medal.

The Organizer reserves the right to merge categories if competitor numbers fall below 4 (four).

2.4. **Compulsory safety equipment.**

Coaches must ensure that the participants have all Taekwon-do ITF sparring protective equipment:

- **Gloves.** Open palm gloves possible to use only for Cadet (11-13 y.) but all Age groups use boxing gloves ITF standard (10 oz) in blue and red color. Other colors will not be allowed;
- **Head guards** with close top, blue and red color. Other colors will not be allowed;
- **Foot protectors,** ITF standard safety equipment for sparring can be any neutral color and brand;
- **Shin guards & Mouth guard** are compulsory for all ages;
- **Groin protector** is compulsory only for male for all ages;
- **Chest protector** (inside Dobok) is compulsory only for female from 14 y. old;

3. **The procedure of official protest.**

In case of protest, the official representative of team or coach must:

- a) Immediately after the end of the disputed bout, turn to the Jury president at the table near the ring, and verbally declare the desire to file a protest.
- b) The judge starts time count of 5 minutes, during which the coach write and submits a protest to the Jury president table together with fee payment of 50 € (euro).
- c) The protest is considered by the Chief of Umpires committee of the competition.

During the consideration of the protest, the competitions on this ring are suspended until a final decision is made. In any case payment does not refundable.

4. **Accommodation.**

We recommended you to make the booking nearest to competitions hall 3-stars Hotel "DoDo", it has very friendly prices and good situated.

5. Transfer.

If you need transfer from AIRPORT or RAILWAY station to the hotel or/and to the stadium, please contact us before Deadline. Cost for transfer **20.00 EUR** per person. Transfer offer include: a meeting at the airport or the Railway station, bus to the hotel and transfer to the airport or Railway station after finish of competitions. For small teams we recommend to use taxi app **Bolt** or **Yandex Taxi** (cost from Airport to Center near the 5 EUR) or call tel. +(371) 8383 to RedCub Taxi (www.redcub.lv) for 8 pers. (It will be best price).

- 7.1. For the change of the weight category or section in the Patterns competition **on registration & weight-in** the penalty for each change in the application is 10.00 EUR
- 7.2. For submission of the final application after the specified deadline or delay of the team for registration - 50.00 EUR

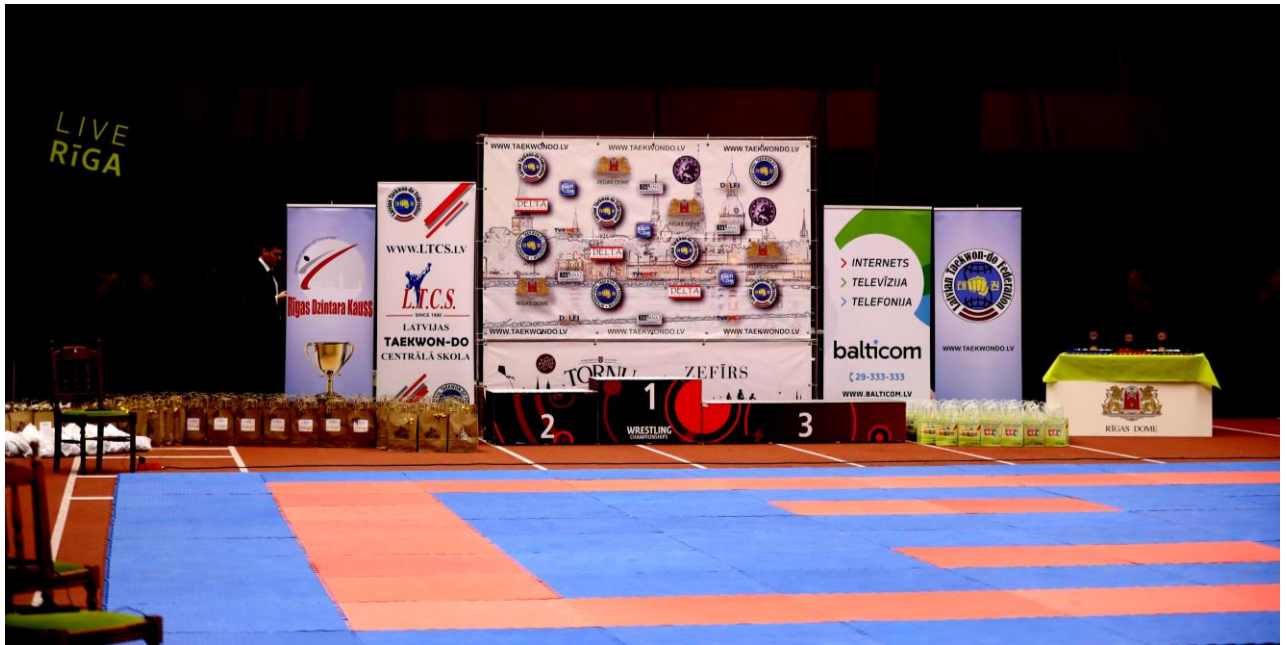
